We look forward to seeing you all there! Thank You in advance for all your support

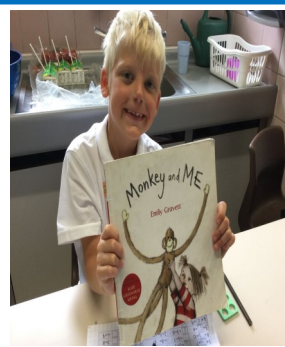
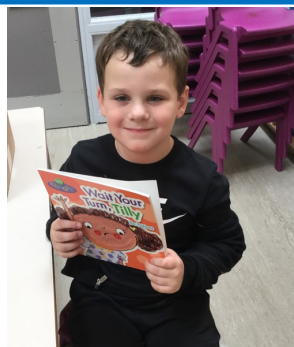
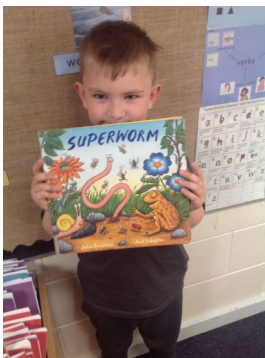
