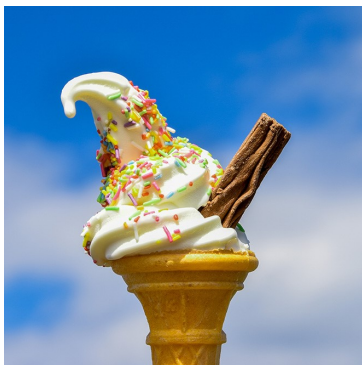


Friday 13th June 2025
