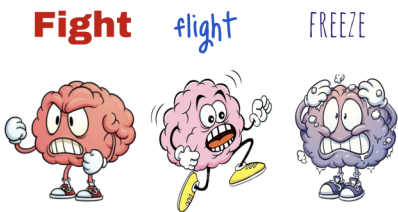
KS1 Readers of the Week
