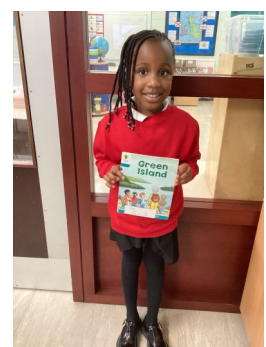
I hope that everyone has a restful break next week and look forward to seeing everyone when we return on Monday 2nd June for our last half term of the year.

National Numeracy Day

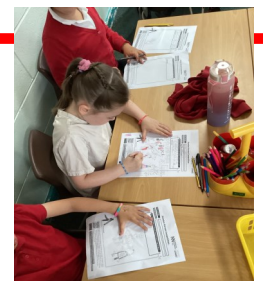
The Money Edition

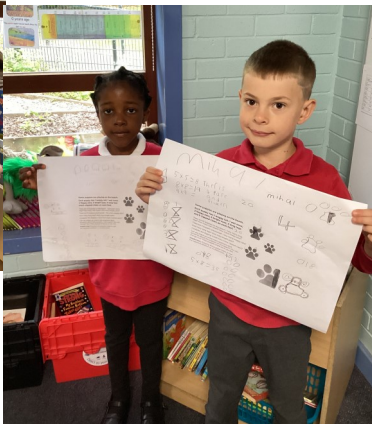
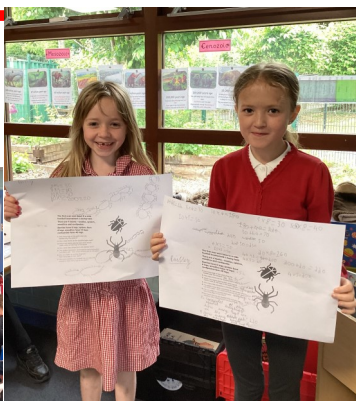
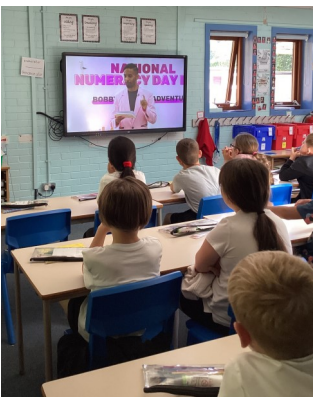


We had lots of fun in Year 2 celebrating National Numeracy Day!

Year 3 took part in National Numeracy Day. They enjoyed the live assembly and practised their multiplication skills by drawing pictures and bar models to help them solve problems.

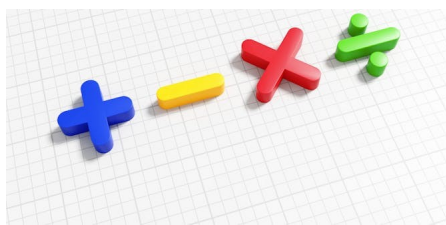

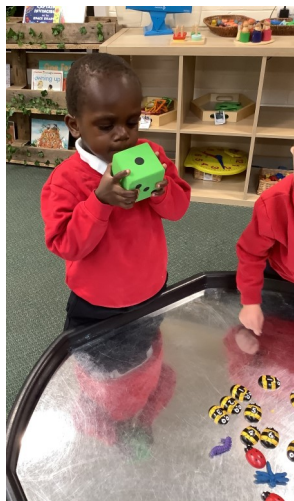
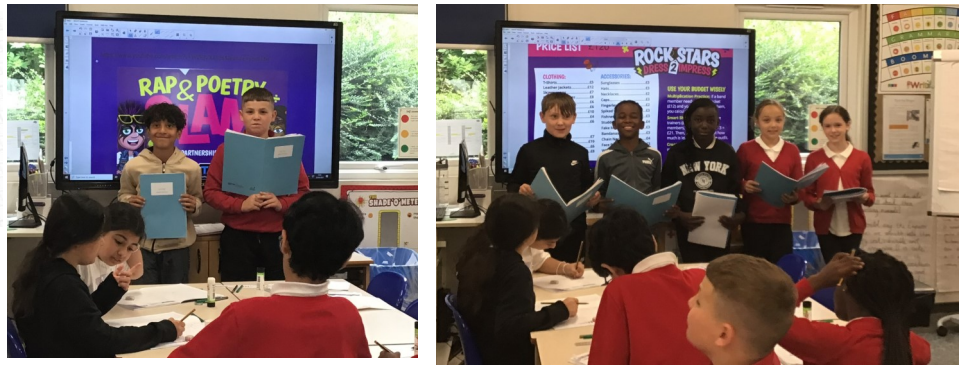
The children in Year 4 have really enjoyed budgeting and designing outfits for their TTRS Rockstars! Here are some examples of our Mathematicians in action!
