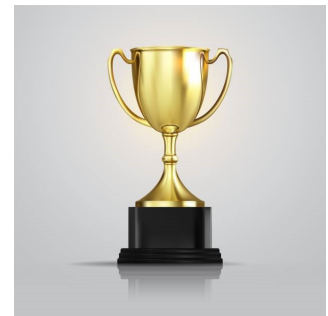

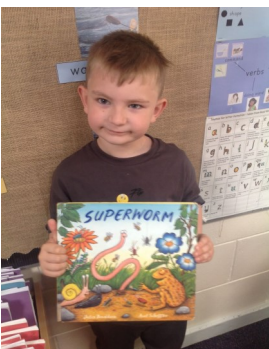
Fantastic effort, sportsmanship and all round performance shown by our year 5&6 boys' football team. There were some great goals and a fantastic penalty save!!
