Thank you for all of your support from the whole of the foundation team!

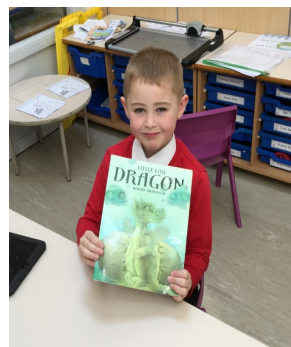

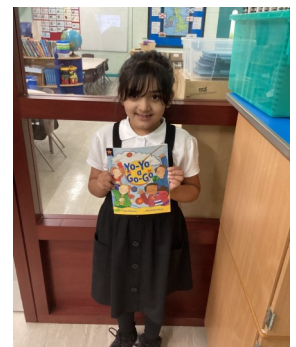

## Place2Be



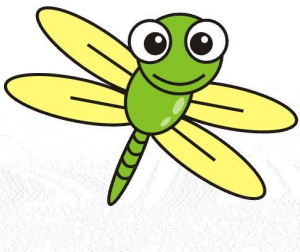
Place2Be, our in-school mental health support service, has a variety of resources to help you support your child's wellbeing.
