Any that we were unable to hand out have been posted.

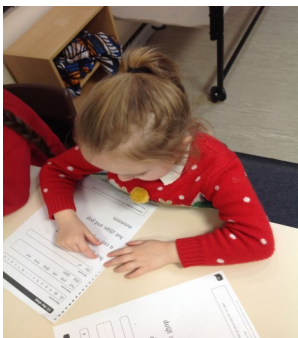

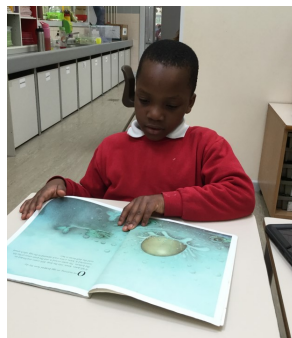

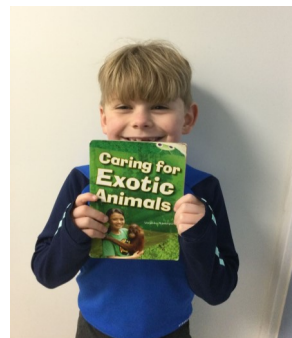

For working hard to learn all her set 2 sounds! Well done!



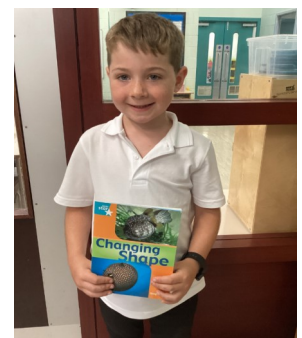
**1F**
