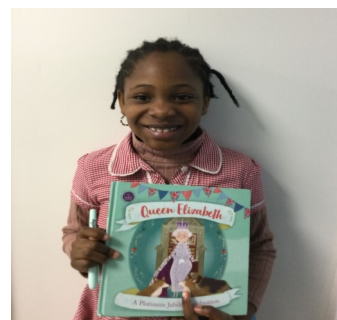
After the holidays, 5W will be taught by Mrs Stamer on Monday and Tuesday, and by Mrs Wilson for the rest of the week.
