Road Safety

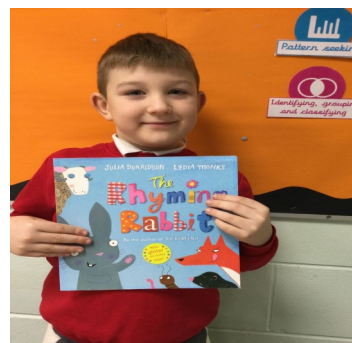
