Santa said that all the children were smart and polite and he loved meeting them all.

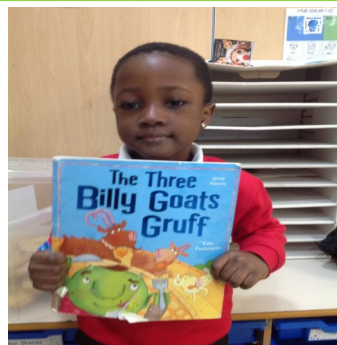
