



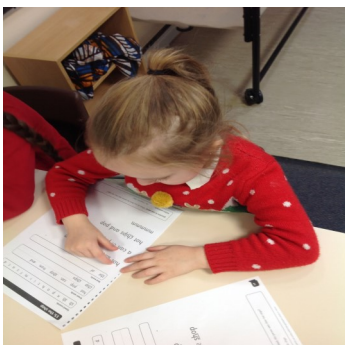
# Grange Farm Grapevine
