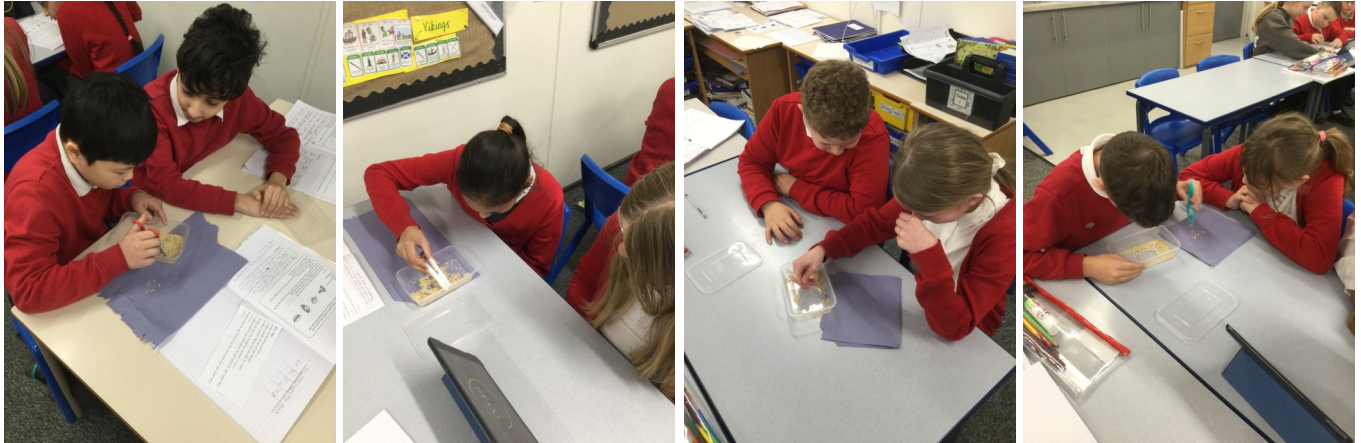


Grange Farm Grapevine

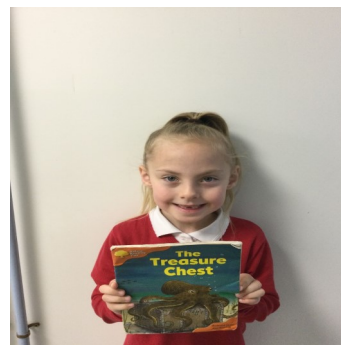

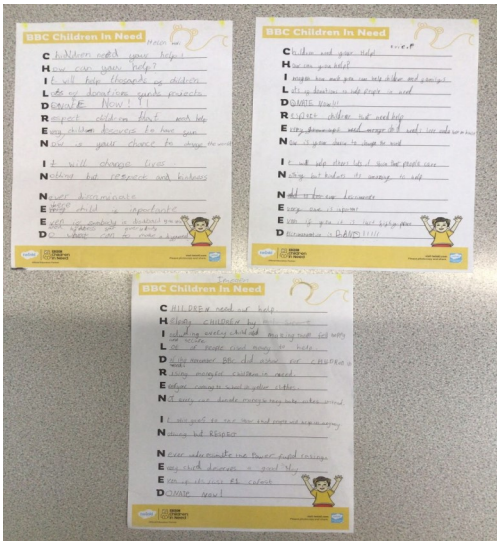
