For reading at home this week.

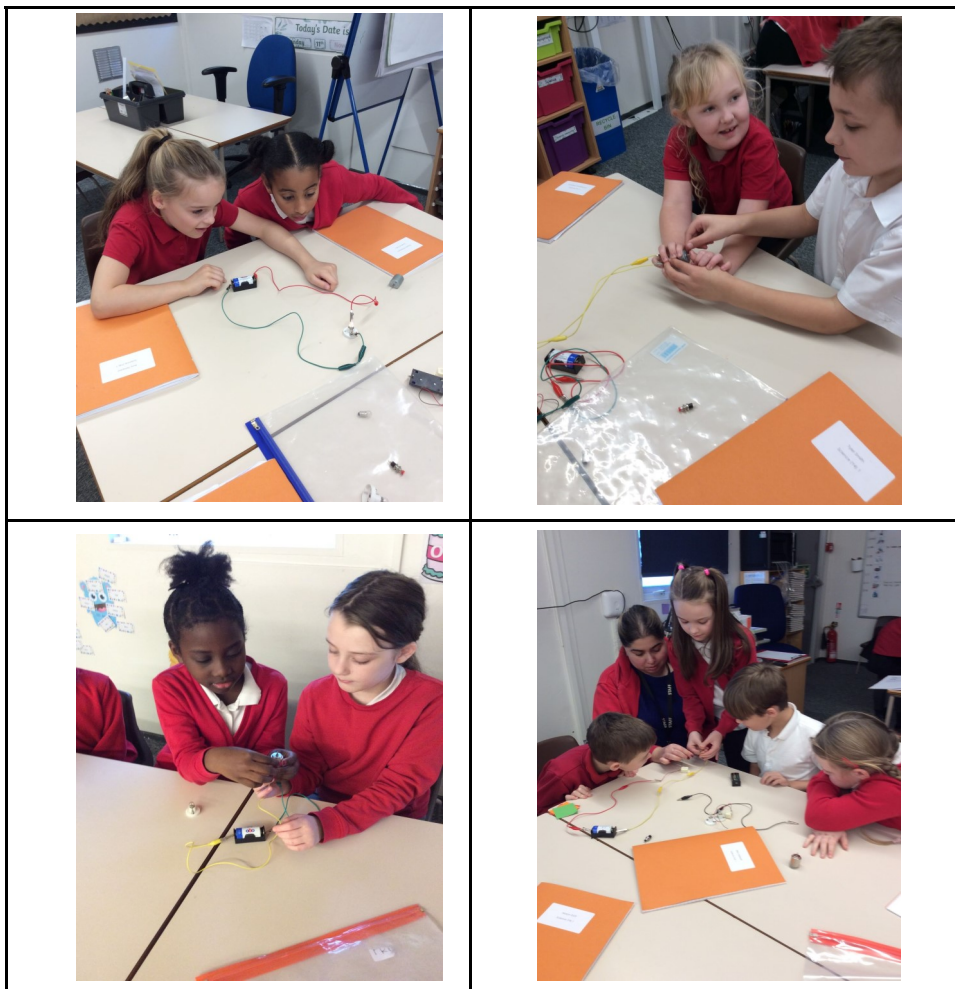
Year 5 science
