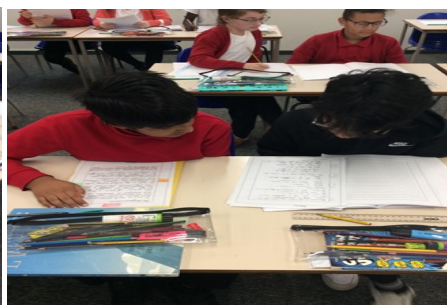


# Grange Farm Grapevine
