## First Aid Week






### Is your child starting school in September 2025?

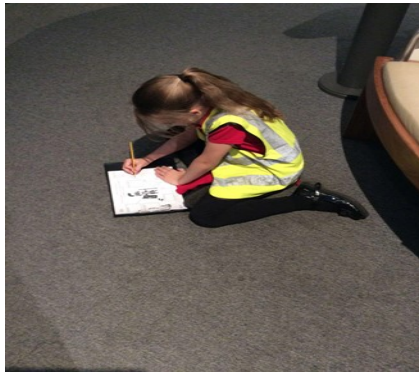
