Our Children's Activity Pack is full of fun, nature-based activities, designed to inspire outdoor exploration along the Trail or in your local green spaces.

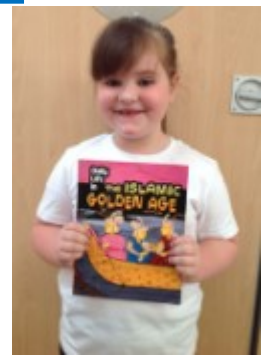
