Thursday 11th December is our school Christmas lunch day. All children are invited to wear a Christmas jumper if they wish, as it is also National Christmas Jumper Day.



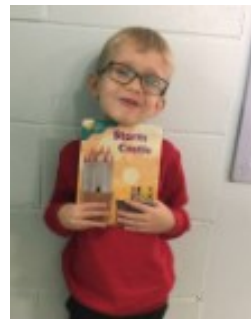
