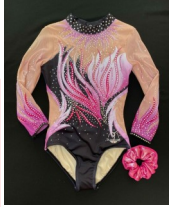




Grange Farm Grapevine

That means feeling like you're part of something, such as your family, your school, your group of friends or a team. These happy moments help us feel connected, valued, and accepted.



When we feel like we belong, we feel happy, safe, and ready to learn and play. It helps us grow strong in our minds and bodies and it makes it easier to make friends, do well in school, and feel good about ourselves.



During Children's Mental Health Week, we'll be talking about how we can help everyone feel like they belong. We will share **This is my Place** so we can learn from each other about what makes us feel happy. We'll learn how to be kind, include others, and make sure no one feels left out, because everyone deserves to feel like they have a place where they are accepted, cared for and loved.



During the week we will be doing lots of activities in school to help support this. One of these will be an **assembly on Monday 9th February**. Our school uniform is a way of showing that Grange Farm **'Is my Place'**. On the day of the assembly, we are offering the children a chance to **come dressed in something that shows another place where they belong, if they wish**. This could be a hobby, a sports club, or something that shows cultural identity. However, **school uniform already shows your child is part of Grange Farm and that 'This is their place.'**

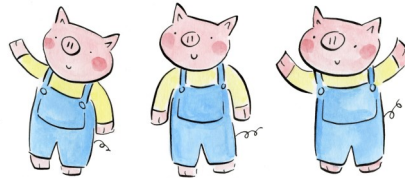
