Thank you to the volunteers, to everyone who donated to the sale and a big thank you to everyone who came and helped us raise a massive £374.40.



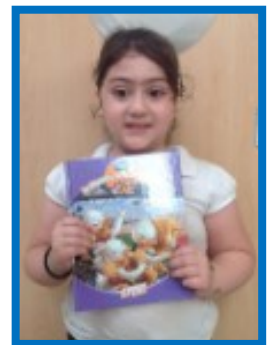
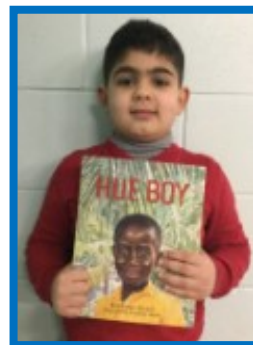
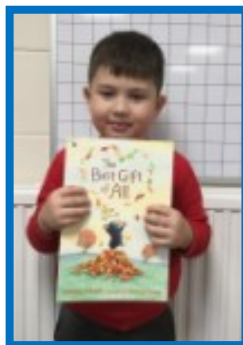

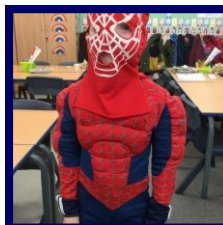
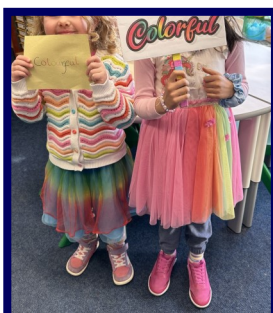
We will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 5th March.
