

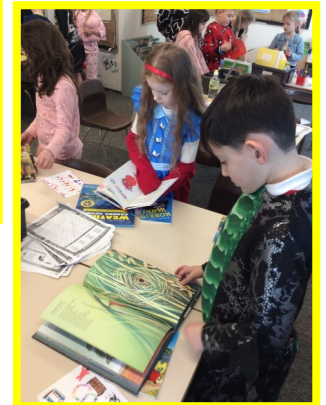

They also enjoyed choosing their very own book to take home from the Children's Book Project.



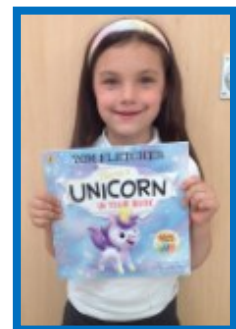
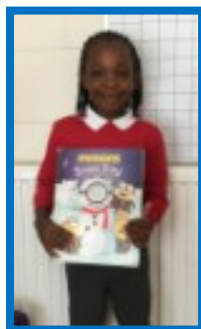

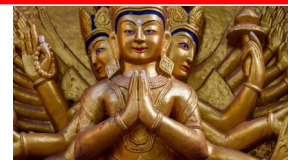
World Book Day continued.
