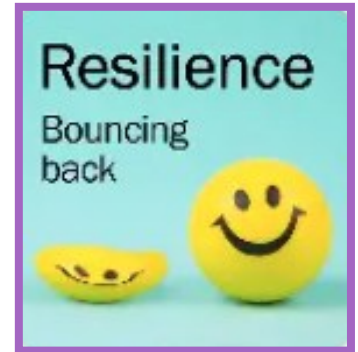




Grange Farm Grapevine

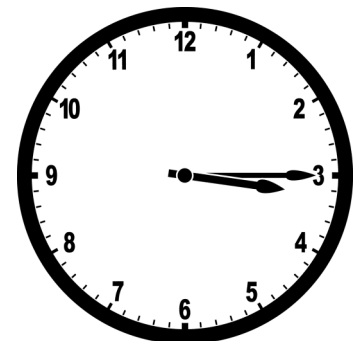
