For moving up 2 reading levels - well done!

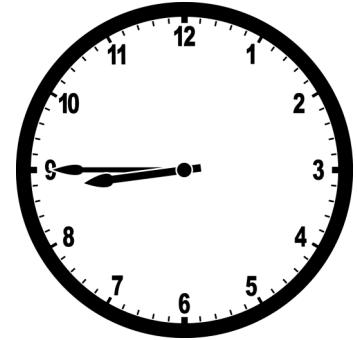
