This is a chance for your child to meet other children that will be in their class.

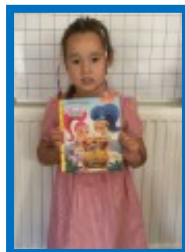

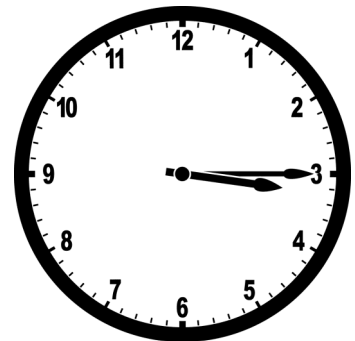
