Weekly attendance numbers for the week ending 26th June.

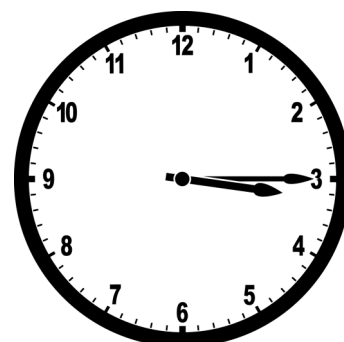
The HOT weather had a massive impact on last week's attendance as you can see, all the figures for every class are in **RED**. No class managed a day when all their children were in school.
