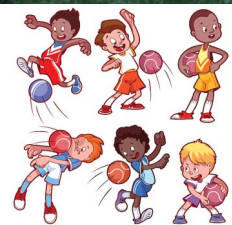
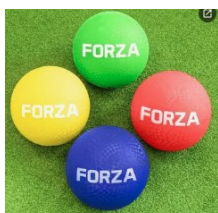
Year 3 - Volcanoes
