A Fresh Start for Our School House



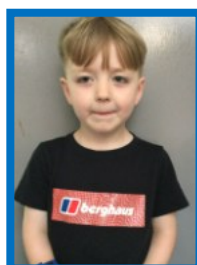

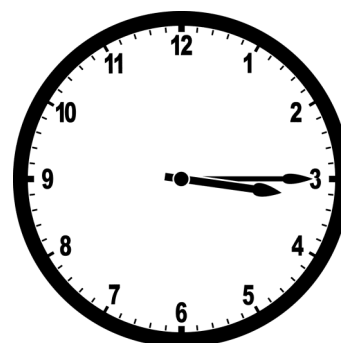

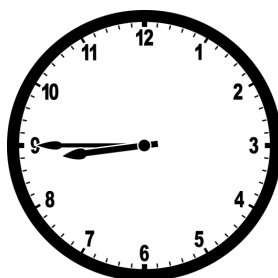
School finish time

Dear parents,
Places are now available to join a new 12-week football course every Friday at Dixons Trinity Chapelton, which is open to both boys and girls.

Our courses teach children correct football techniques by FA qualified coaches who have full DBS (with clearance to work with children). The course is 12 weeks, through football, building confidence for new beginners and meeting some more complex, advanced players.

We provide a half per player for the majority of our skills training children get more touches of the ball and improve whilst this conventional coaching where children are waiting around to have a turn. The sessions are held on the fantastic 3G pitch so please wear trainers or 3G boots. Players are also advised to bring a cold drink for the session.

The club has links to local junior teams of which players will be able to play for at the weekend. Players who show advanced ability in the course will be recommended to train at professional standards. Players who have previously attended courses are currently playing for Bradford City, Sheffield United, Sheffield Wednesday, Manchester United, Liverpool, Leeds United, Everton and Chelsea.

The cost of the course is just £8.67 per week, which is payable in two instalments. The first payment of £30 is due when booking your child and the second payment of £30 due at the first session. Parents are encouraged to watch the sessions but are welcome to leave children in every session is fully supervised.

"NEW TOURNAMENT FORMAT"
Every four weeks we have a tournament in order for the children to put their new found skills into practice with medals awarded at the end of the course for various categories.

ALL PLAYERS WILL RECEIVE A TROPHY AND MEDAL at the presentation, which is held on the final week of the course. Additional trophies will also be awarded in each group from categories including: Best Attacker, Star Player, Most Improved Player, Most Promising Player and Hardest Working Player.
